



New Jesuit Volunteer 2016 Timeline

During the next couple of months, you will receive a lot of information from JVC. In an effort to paint a broad picture of things to consider and important deadlines to remember, we have put together a short timeline with approximate touch points. Be gentle with yourself and don't rush into anticipating what's next, but be present in the moment and embrace all that surrounds you. Our desire for you is that you may strive to slow down and walk in the pace of our God during this time. A prayer for you:

*God is my pace-setter, I shall not rush;
God makes me stop and rest for quiet intervals;
God provides me with images of stillness which restores my serenity.
God leads me in ways of efficiency through calmness of mind, and God's guidance is peace.
Even though I have a great many things to accomplish each day, I will not fret, for God's presence is here.
God's timelessness, God's all- importance will keep me in balance.
God prepares refreshment and renewal in the midst of my activity by anointing my head with God's oils of tranquility.

April – mid-May: During this time, we invite you to begin to develop ways to communicate your formation story, as you begin to prepare for this next phase of your journey. You will receive information on the *Send Me to Serve Campaign*, resources on enculturation preparation, and logistical details. In mid-May, you will participate in a Welcome Call with fellow JVs and JVC staff. We encourage you to attend to your current needs in your day-to-day environments, given that many of you will be preparing to graduate from college.

Mid-May: JVC will provide support materials to contextualize what it means to live into the JVC mission, understand a cross-cultural context, developing awareness of self, and experiencing spaces to share your story with those who will be supporting you along the way. We encourage you to explore and research these themes on your own as well, as the preparation one engages in the pre-immersion phase is proven to be a critical indicator for one's success in the initial phase of acculturation.

June: Preparation for departure, preparing to fully participate and not anticipate, and engage the uncertainty that might still exist in the process. Begin to think through how to prepare your family and other relationships that will be supporting you post departure. The IP will provide additional information on expectations for orientation, materials needed to be prepared, and responding to last minute inquiries.

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July 1-6: Saying good-bye for Early Departures, a time of “in-betweenness” for Late Departures. We encourage you to plan as little as possible during this time to focus on relationships that will continue to support you and to give yourself the flexibility of time, without feeling hurried, of being able to engage the unexpected things that come up.
