POST-JVC GRADUATE SCHOOL OPPORTUNITIES

JVC wants to make applicants, JVs, and FJVs aware of graduate schools that offer scholarship opportunities for Jesuit Volunteers to continue their education after their year of service. Opportunities for free or reduced tuition include:

- [The Magis Program](#) at Loyola University Chicago (tuition-free degree in theology, social work, and more for FJVs, who live in community while they study)
 - The [Trinity Fellows Program](#) at Marquette University (thirteen fields of study available; full-tuition plus stipend for FJVs)
 - [Fordham University graduate program in International Political Economy and Development](#) (tuition-free [Arrupe Fellowship](#) for FJVs)
 - [Gonzaga University Law School](#) (offers [scholarship](#) for those committed to serve the public interest)
 - [DePaul University Ozanam Scholarship](#) (full-tuition for FJVs)
 - [Carnegie Mellon University's Heinz College School of Public Policy](#) (\$6000 scholarship for FJVs)
 - [Santa Clara University Pastoral Ministries](#) program offers 25% off tuition for FJVs
 - [St. John's School of Theology](#) offers 50% off tuition for FJVs
 - [Georgetown University offers 15% off tuition](#) for FJVs in continuing studies
 - [Jesuit School of Theology](#) – Presidential Scholarship offers full-tuition MDiv degree
